## **Entertainment Book Sale**

A suggestion was made to introduce Entertainment Books as a new fundraiser to the school. These These are books full of discount vouchers (some of them are really great). Vouchers are for two for one trips to just about every museum, gallery, cinema, theatre and touristy thing to do in Sydney, plus great offers for many restaurants, cafes and fast food outlets, beauty and hair salons. One book lasts for a year - from 1 June to 31 May. An online option is also now available as an alternative to the voucher book. The books sell for \$65, with about \$13 going back to the selling organisation. Not many organisations in Bondi Beach appear to offer these entertainment books.

The books could be advertised through the newsletters / Skoolbag app alone. Parents could then submit an order form with payment and receive their books. Alternatively, we could set up a stand at morning lines in the fortnight between the Trivia Night and the school holidays. During that time we will still have access to an Eftpos machine which could be used to take payments on the spot.

In either case, we require at least 2 volunteers to put this idea into practice: one to coordinate with the company regarding purchases, delivery, etc.; the other person to coordinate the sale at school. The person who made the suggestion offered to provide support but is unable to coordinate the effort this year because of personal reasons.
